# Annual Report 2010–11

Survey summaries: ethnicity, nationality, religion, age and disability

## Background

A survey of a random sample of prisoners or detainees representative of the total population in that establishment is carried out for all full inspections (this includes full announced, full unannounced and full follow-up inspections). The survey results provide one source of evidence for the inspection but when combined also provide comparative information for each functional type of establishment.

The following tables are a full colour version of Appendix 5 of the Annual Report 2010–11. They present the results of questions about ethnicity, nationality, religion, age and disability in surveys relating to inspection reports published between April 2010 and March 2011. The survey comparisons indicate where statistically significant differences exist between the two groups of prisoner compared, for example white compared to black and minority ethnic prisoners, or British national compared to foreign national prisoners.

A key to aid interpretation of the survey data is presented at the top of each table.
