*Who is the body one should complain to if it is discovered that a management member of a housing association has falsified the former HCA document on Mortgage Rescue Syndication by deleting or obscuring a sentence from with intent to take away the tenancy rights of a tenant ?*

By way of background information, the remit of HM Crown Prosecution Service inspectorate (HMCPST) is to inspect the Crown Prosecution Service and the Serious Fraud Office. HMCPST does not have the powers to intervene in any individual cases and has no statutory authority to look into complaints.
