FOI Request

Thank you for your Freedom of Information received 24th July. In your request you asked for the following information.

Please may you provide me, in Microsoft Excel or an equivalent electronic format, with a list of invoices that were not paid within 30 days for the last 6 financial years (2017/18 to 2022/23 inclusive) which would feed into the Regulation 113 Notice you are required to publish each year as part of your obligations under The Public Contracts Regulations 2015, with the following information for each invoice (where available):

- *The name of the Supplier*
- *Supplier email address*
- *Supplier company registration number*
- *Supplier postal address*
- *Supplier telephone number*
- *Supplier website*
- *The date of the invoice*
- *The invoice reference*
- *The gross value of the Invoice*
- *The date the invoice should have been paid by*
- *The actual payment date of the invoice*
- *The total amount of interest liability due to late payment of the invoice*
- *The total amount of interest paid to the supplier due to late payment of the invoice.*

For the avoidance of doubt we request the data behind payment performance summaries for Regulation 113 Notices, not the summaries themselves.

I can confirm that we do not hold any information in the scope of this request.

As part of our duty to provide advice and assistance, HMCPsi is a small government department of 25 staff and as such we have a shared service agreement with another larger department who provide our financial services.
