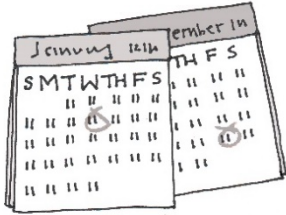




# Inspection of HMP/YOI East Sutton Park



Inspectors visited this prison in  
September and October 2023.



We wanted to find out if things were  
better, the same or worse for women  
since we last visited in 2016.



We did this by:

- looking around the prison
- asking prisoners and staff to fill in a questionnaire
- speaking to prisoners
- speaking to staff and helpers
- reading documents.

## What did we find?



**Women felt safe and there was not much violence.**

We gave the prison 4 out of 4 for this.



**Women were treated well by staff and rooms were clean.**

We gave the prison 4 out of 4 for this.



**Women needed more support in their learning and skills.**

We gave the prison 3 out of 4 for this.



**Prisoners had good help to get ready to leave prison.**

We gave the prison 4 out of 4 for this.

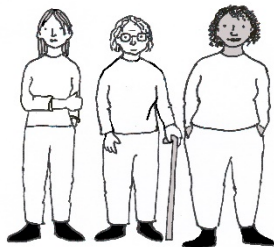
## What should the prison do?



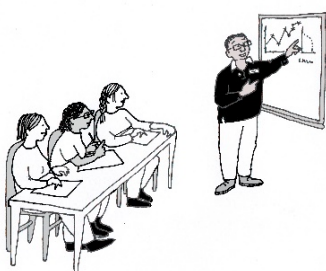
We want the governor to read our inspection report. You can find the report in the prison library.

We want the governor to make a plan. The plan should tell us how they will fix any problems at HMP East Sutton Park and make things better for prisoners.

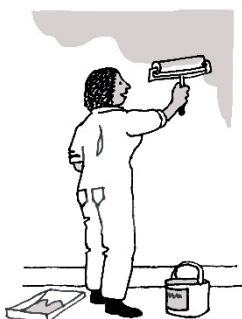
# What do we want to happen?



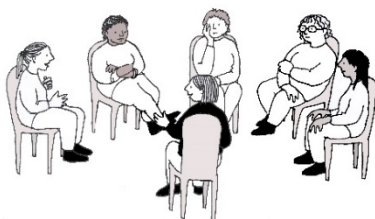
We want all women to be treated fairly.



We want teachers to make sure women write down the skills they have learned, so they can show these to employers.

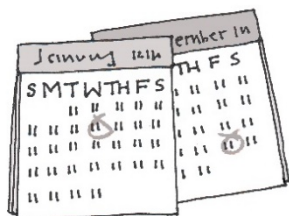


We want the prison to teach women health and safety skills, so that they stay safe at work.

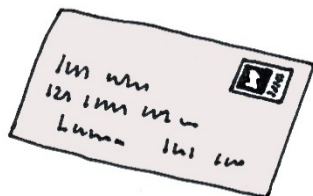


We want women to learn important things in education and work, like respect and treating people equally.
