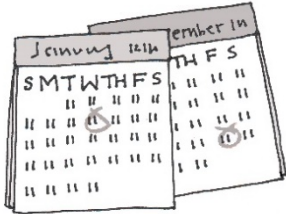
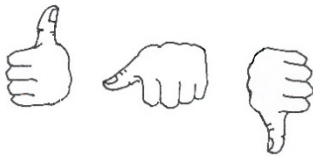




Inspection of HMP Morton Hall



Inspectors visited this prison in October and November 2023.



We wanted to find out how things were for prisoners in the jail.



We did this by:

- looking around the prison
- asking prisoners and staff to fill in a questionnaire
- speaking to prisoners
- speaking to staff and helpers
- reading documents.

What did we find?



Prisoners felt safe.

We gave the prison 4 out of 4 for this.



Prisoners were treated well by staff and the prison was clean.

We gave the prison 4 out of 4 for this.



Prisoners did not have enough time out of their cells. Teaching and work were not good enough.

We gave the prison 2 out of 4 for this.



Prisoners did not enough help to get ready to leave Morton Hall.

We gave the prison 2 out of 4 for this.

What should the prison do?



We want the governor to read our inspection report. You can find the report in the prison library.

We want the governor to make a plan. The plan should tell us how they will fix the problems at HMP Morton Hall and make things better for prisoners.

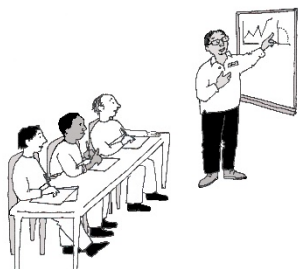
What do we want to happen?



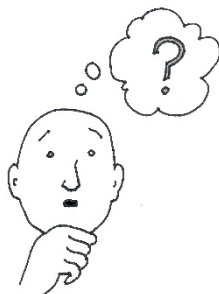
We want prisoners to get help with mental health problems.

We want more prisoners to get skills and qualifications.



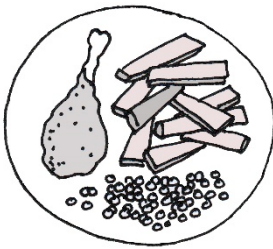
We want staff to help prisoners who need extra support.



We want the Home Office to make sure prisoners are released on time.



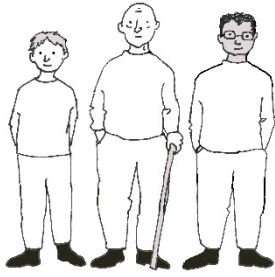
We want more prisoners to move to open prisons and to get temporary release. We want them to be able to do the programmes they need.

We want things in the prison shop to be cheaper. We want things from the shop to be good quality.

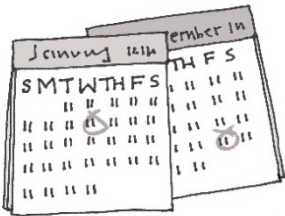


We want all prisoners to be treated fairly.
